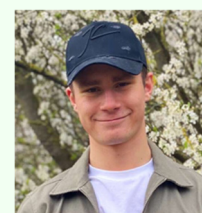

We have teamed up with Active Rutland who have kindly donated enough bicycles for two classes to be able to cycle at one time.

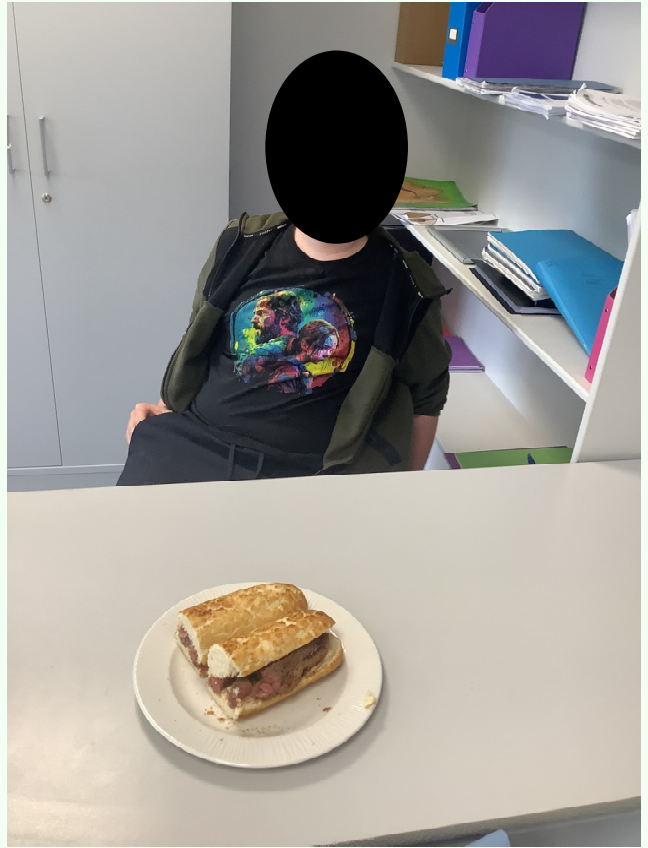
